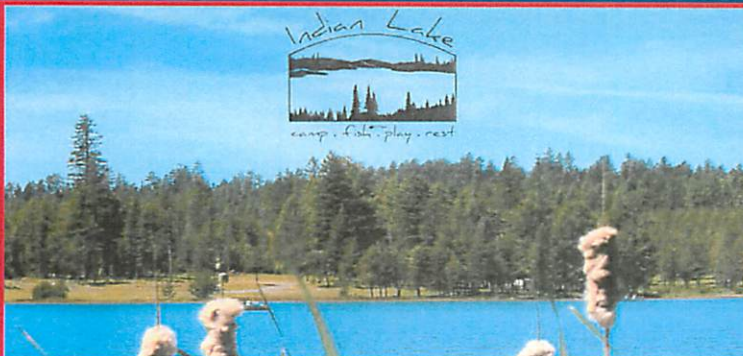

**Lunch will be served out of the food truck at the pool this year, kids taking swim lessons must make other arrangements for transportation to the swim park and a lunch. A seasonal pass may be purchased if the swim lesson kids will be staying at the swim park and riding home on the bus. Parents will be responsible for checking the child in with the swim bus director when she arrives at the Swim park at Noon each day.
