The next Council meeting will be June 2, 2020. The following will be considered:

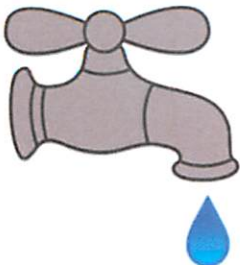
1. Property Purchase Proposal

The Pilot Rock Market opened last weekend and is ready for business. Hopefully you have noticed our Public Works Department and the Oregon Department of Transportation clearing and cleaning up mud on our city streets. The County assessors have been making their rounds documenting damage. Also, the Pendleton street sweeper will be here on June 8 to sweep Main, Alder, 2nd and 3rd streets. The Department of Revenue also visited Pilot Rock and passed out applications for property tax prorations. If you need one, they are available on our website. The clean-up will take time but with everyone's patience and cooperation we will get Pilot Rock back to normal as much as possible.

I do realize that maintaining "Social Distancing" when you are sand bagging and removing debris but keep your protective devices handy. We are a long way from a time when we can freely move about once again. You may think precautions are silly, but we approximately 100,000 deaths in the US, that says its not.
