#### CENSUS IS STILL PROCEEDING

On April 1 the Census officially began and is observed nationwide. The CENSUS website is still available for reporting at 2020census.gov. You do not need the 12-digit Census ID. There is a link below the boxes where the ID would normally go and it says, "if you do not have a Census ID, click here". Most of the City of Pilot Rock does not receive mail at their home and the Census bureau is not sending out mailers to PO boxes. Make sure Pilot Rock receives the money it is eligible for by responding to the 2020 Census - the count of everyone living in the United States. Responding is important to the community. The data provides information where over \$675 billion in federal funding is spent each year in states and communities. That includes money for things like, Medicare Part B, Special education and the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. The money that the City of Pilot Rock receives is based on population so YOUR RESPONSE COUNTS!!
