On Thursday, February 20, a unit from the Oregon Army National Guard based in Pendleton landed a CH47F Chinook on the baseball field behind Pilot Rock High School. All students K-12 were given the opportunity to learn about and tour the aircraft. Many community members also were on hand for the landing and takeoff. The crew members explained to each group of students that the aircraft was built in 2008, had a maximum gross weight of 50,000 pounds, can carry 33 equipped personnel and has the ability to lift up to 17,000 pounds of cargo.

Three of the four crew have ties to Pilot Rock and made the experience even better for the students. SGT Skylar Leasy, a PRHS graduate in 2013, started the process of having this event because he remembered a similar experience when he was a student at Pilot Rock Elementary School. He now is full-time at the unit and either flies missions or is conducting maintenance on the aircraft. CW2 David Brannan, the pilot in command, is also a PRHS graduate from the class of 1990 and enjoyed being able to visit the school. He is an Instructor Pilot/Evaluator for the unit. Another crew member, Jeff Prine lives in Pilot Rock and his son is in the third grade at PRES. He is full time at the unit and either flies, does maintenance or works as the Flight Engineer Instructor. The fourth crew member is Nathan Monk, who is part time with the unit and is a pilot.

Det 1, B Company, 1-168 Aviation has been based out of Pendleton since the late 1980s. The unit deployed to Afghanistan in 2005 and 2010, Iraq and Kuwait in 2015 and will be going back to Afghanistan later this year. The mission of the unit in Oregon includes search and rescue, fire suppression, and support of other military units around the Pacific Northwest. Pilot Rock School District wanted to celebrate with this unit a Military Appreciation Day and the students really enjoyed this opportunity. Many will remember the take off just like Skylar did when he was in elementary school. PRSD thanks the unit for an informative and fun afternoon.

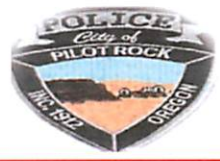
### CENSUS DAY APRIL 1st

On April 1, Census Day is observed nationwide, and the Census website will be available for reporting. You do not need the 12-digit Census ID. There is a link below the boxes where the ID would normally go and it says, "if you do not have a Census ID, click here". Most of the City of Pilot Rock does not receive mail at their home and the Census bureau is not sending out mailers to PO boxes. The mailers contain the 12-digit ID but let's be clear....it is NOT NECESSARY to have the ID in order to report. Make sure Pilot Rock receives the money it is eligible for by responding to the 2020 Census - the count of everyone living in the United States. Responding is important to the community. The data provides information where over \$675 billion in federal funding is spent each year in states and communities. That includes money for things like, Medicare Part B, Special education and the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. The money that the City of Pilot Rock receives is based on population so YOUR RESPONSE COUNTS!!

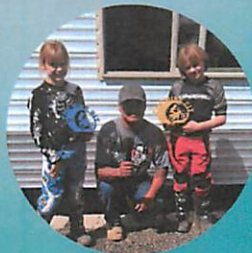
