PUBLIC NOTICE

18.70.105 Parking, Storage or Use of Recreational Vehicles - No recreational vehicle shall be used for living and/or sleeping quarters, when parked or stored on a residential lot, private driveway, city right of way or in any location not approved by the City Council for such use. An exception is allowed with an approved permit for recreational vehicles used for guest accommodations for a maximum of 14 days within a three-month period.

A Public Hearing is scheduled for June 1, 2021 at 6pm and will be heard by Pilot Rock City Council in the Council Chambers at 143 W. Main. Council will review the issue and hear testimony from the public. You are invited to attend this meeting if you wish to present information to the Council for their consideration. If we do not hear from you, either in writing or in person, we will assume that you have no adverse comments regarding this Ordinance.



City Burn Ban to take Effect, June 15-September 15th

8.15.020 Fire season. No person shall burn rubbish during the fire season at any residence, business, or establishment.

8.15.060 Recreational **burning.** Outdoor fires for pleasure, religious, ceremonial or cooking purposes contained within fireplaces, barbecue grills or pits, or other enclosures designed for outdoor recreation or cooking are permitted.
