#### CITY ORDINANCE ADOPTION

The City of Pilot Rock has every municipal code available online at <a href="www.cityofpilotrock.org">www.cityofpilotrock.org</a>. On the home page, click on "City Code". At the top right-hand side is a search feature to look up any topic. The City Charter is the basic document that defines the organization, powers, functions, and essential procedures of the city government. The Charter is, therefore, the most important legal document of any city. Pilot Rock Charter has a very specific process to pass an ordinance (law). Chapter IV Section 16 Ordinance Adoption states:

- (a) Except as authorized by subsection (b), adoption of an ordinance requires approval by a majority of the council at two meetings.
- (b) The Council may adopt an ordinance at a single meeting by the unanimous approval of a least a quorum (minimum of 4 Councilors) of the council, provided the proposed ordinance is available in writing to the public at least one week before the meeting.
- (c) Any substantive amendment to a proposed ordinance must be read aloud or made available in writing to the public before the council adopts the ordinance at that meeting.
- (d) After the adoption of an ordinance, the vote of each member must be entered into the council minutes.
- (e) After adoption of an ordinance, the city custodian of records must endorse it with the date of adoption and the custodian's name and title.
- (f) Every ordinance shall be fully and distinctly read in an open council meeting on two different days previous to being put upon its final passage, but any ordinance may be introduced, read twice, once in full and once by title, and put on its final passage at a single meeting, provide that when copies of a proposed ordinance are available to the public and members of the council at the commencement of a council meeting at which any action is taken on said ordinance, either introduction or vote, it may be read by title only in lieu of full reading unless one or more councilors demand that it be read in full.
