2022 CITY COUNCIL ELECTION

At the 2022 General Election on November 8th, one Mayor and three Councilor positions will appear on the ballot. The filing period for interested candidates begins on June 1, 2022 and all filing requirements must be completed by 5:00 p.m. on August 30, 2022. All the open positions are a four-year term and are as follows:

- Mayor - Currently held by Randy Gawith
- Councilor - Currently held by Aliina Kirby
- Councilor - Currently held by Tegan Kaneaster
- Councilor - Currently held by Paula Evoniuk
- Ø All positions are non-partisan.
- Ø Council positions are elected at large- meaning candidates may reside in any area of the community.
- Ø All terms will begin on January 1, 2023 and shall take office at the first regular Council meeting following the election.
- Ø All positions are volunteer/non-paid.

To qualify as a candidate, you must be a registered voter and a resident of the City of Pilot Rock who has resided continuously in the city during the 12 months immediately preceding the election. Candidate filing forms are available in City Hall or contact the City Recorder for more information.

The Pendleton Lions have partnered with the Oregon Lions Sight and Hearing Foundation and **Vision Source Pendleton** to provide glasses for those who would otherwise not be able to provide them. People needing glasses fill out a Lions of Oregon Application form and submit it to the Pendleton Lions Club. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and must also have been rejected by their insurance carrier for eyeglass support. Applicants without insurance must have sought insurance eligibility prior to applying through the Lions Vision program.

Successful applicants are referred to Vision Source Pendleton for an eye examination. there are basic frame options listed. The prescription is then referred to the Oregon Lions Eyeglass Assistance Program where the eyeglasses are produced. The glasses are then sent back to Vision Source where they are fitted to the applicant.

There is a \$20 co-pay required of applicants at the time of fitting. For those who can demonstrate no income the co-pay may be waived.
